But what’ll happen is you’ll become a person He can’t use, a person He can’t bless, a person He can barely reward.

Remember you can lose your rewards. [2 John 8]

Let’s not be the least in His Kingdom.

The moral law of God hasn't changed one bit.

Are there some commandments that are more important than others?

Jesus, Himself graded, prioritized the commandments.
