THE FINISHED WORK OF CHRIST

The Debt is Cancelled
Christ wiped out the legal requirements against us, nailing the debt to the cross.

Freedom Through Union
By faith, believers have died in Christ and are no longer bound by legalism.

THE STANDARD OF GRACE

Reflecting God's Character
The moral law remains pertinent as an extension of God's nature and holiness.

Impact on Kingdom Status
Obedience to God's commands determines if one is "least" or "great" in the Kingdom.
