The sacrifice of Christ, even though it had not yet been given, was sufficient for the Old Testament Saints.

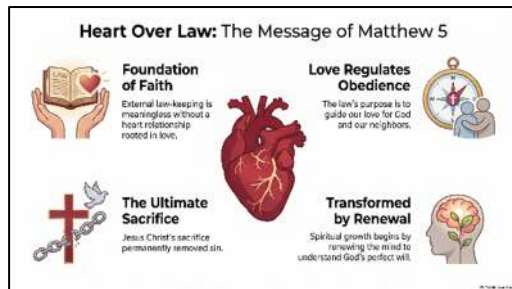
